### Immunoglobulin (IG)

- What
  - Blood product derived from human blood plasma
  - Contains antibodies
- Who
  - Immunosuppressed patients
  - Dermatology, hematology, immunology, infectious disease, transplant, neurology, rheumatology
- How
  - IV
  - Sub-cut
  - Inpatient or outpatient settings



### Immunoglobulin

- More IVIG is being prescribed
- Potential for global shortage
- Saskatchewan is one of the highest per capita users of IVIG across the nation





## **Current Process**IVIG





## **Current Process Limitations**

- Differences across the province
- Lack of overarching patient registry
- Infusion nurses tasked with administrative work
- Used for non-approved clinical indications
- Over-prescribing IVIG (not using adjusted weight)





- Mandated by the Ministry of Health
- Goal: Conserve IVIG use while maintaining patient safety
  - Prescribe within the approved clinical indications
  - Use adjusted weights
  - Identify patients who qualify for subcutaneous IG
  - Support brand switching
  - Form province wide patient registry




**Support and Sustainability** 

- Support the implementation of a new Provincial Order Set
  - Used across the province
  - Online access (inpatient and outpatient)
  - IG Nurse Navigators review order
    - Verify dosing
    - Ensure approved clinical indication
    - Aid in entering details into patient registry
